Ordinance, No., 190

An Ordinance to provide for the naming of certain streets in Hackblum's Third and Fourth additions to the city of Albany, and to regulate and control said streets.

The People of the city of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section I. That the streets lying east of Hill street, and running north and south in Hackblum's Third and Fourth additions to the city of Albany according to the maps, plats and surveys of said additions now on file and of record in the office of the Recorder of Linn County, shall be known and designated as follows: The first street east of Hill street shall be known as Main street, the second street east of Hill street shall be known as Sherman street, the third street east of Hill street shall be known as Oak street, the fourth street east of Hill street shall be known as Pine street, the fifth street east of Hill street shall be known as ~~Shelton~~ Harrison street, the sixth street east of Hill street shall be known as Clevehand street, and the seventh street east of Hill street shall be known as Denver street.

Section II. That the streets named in section I. of

this Ordinance shall be subject to the same Courtly regulations, and improvements, as now provided by Ordinance for other streets of the City of Albany.

Section III: That, the Recorder file a copy of this Ordinance in the office of the Recorder of Linn County.

Section IV: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
