

Ordinance No 227

Am to Amend Section 4. of ordinance no 210. entitled "An ordinance to create the Office of Superintendent of Streets, and to define his duties, to provide for and regulate the establishment and alteration of the grade of Streets and alleys or any part thereof and providing for the grading of Streets and alleys or any part thereof, and for the construction, improvement, and repairing of sidewalks, pavements, Streets, alleys, sewers, drains, bridges and aqueducts within the limits of the City of Albany, when in the judgement of the Common Council of said City such work is necessary, and to provide for the assessment, and collection of the costs, and expenses thereof and providing for the recording, and enforcement of liens upon the property adjacent to such improvements.  
Approved by the Mayor April 16<sup>th</sup> 1891.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows

Section 1. That Section 4. of ordinance No 210. entitled "An ordinance to create the office of Superintendent of Streets and to define his duties to provide for and regulate the establishment and alteration of the grade of Streets, and alleys, or any part thereof and providing for the grading of Streets and alleys or any part thereof, and for the construction, improvement and repairing of sidewalks, pavements, Streets, alleys, sewers, drains, bridges and aqueducts within the limits of the City of Albany when in the judgement of the Common Council of said City, such

work is necessary, and to provide for the assessment, and collection of the costs and expenses thereof, and providing for the recording, and enforcement of liens upon the property adjacent to such improvements approved April 16<sup>th</sup> 1891. It and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows

mark -

"Section 4." After the hearing mentioned in Section 3, of this ordinance shall be finished if the Council shall determine by resolution that the proposed improvement, alteration or establishment of grade or repair specified in such notice be made. Thereafter the Recorder of the City, shall forthwith advertise for bids for the making of such improvement, alteration or establishment of grade, or repair, as the case may be, and the contract therefor shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, unless otherwise ordered by the Council. Such advertisement shall be by either written or printed notices posted by the Marshal, in at least three public places, in the City of Albany. Such notices shall contain a brief description of the improvement, alteration or establishment of grade, or repair, proposed to be made, and the time when, and place where the bid will be opened. Such notice shall be signed by the Recorder, and shall be posted at least 7. full days before the time of opening the bids. If no bid for the making of such improvement, alteration, establishment of grade, or repair, as the case may be, shall be filed with the Recorder of the City, by the time fixed, in such notices,

for the opening of bids, then such improvement, alteration or establishment of grade, or repair, shall be made by the Superintendent of Streets, as the agent and representative of the city, and he shall be paid therefor by the City, after his bill shall have been audited by the Council.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force, and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.

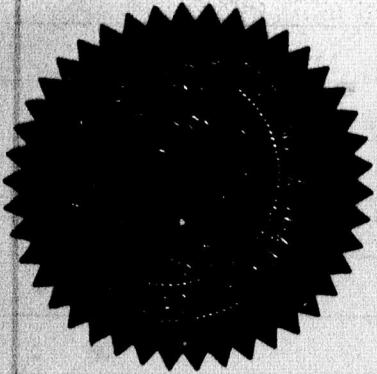
