Ordinance No. 237.

Are Ordinance providing for the manner of constructing sidewalks upon Vine street from the south end of said Vine street to Third street, and upon Eighth street from the east line of Vine street to the east line of Railroad street, and upon Thurston street from the north line of Seventh street to the north line of Water street, in the City of Albany Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows.

Section 1.

Section 1. That the sidewalks upon Vine street, from the south end of said Vine street to Third street, and upon Eighth street from the east line of Vine street to the east line of Railroad street, and upon Thurston street from the north line of Seventh street to the north line of Water street in the City of Albany Oregon shall be four (4) feet in width, and shall be constructed as follows to wit: There shall be beamings three inches thick, (3x4) and four inches wide laid upon the ground or other suitable support, at a distance apart of six (6) feet; there shall be laid upon said beaming three (3) tiers of stringers red or yellow fir, three inches thick (3x4) and four inches wide, and either twelve (12) or eighteen (18) feet in length; said stringers shall be placed upon the beamings at suitable and equal distances apart, and be well secured by being nailed to the beamings with twenty penny nails. The decking placed upon said stringers shall be plank one and a half (1 1/2) inches thick, four (4) feet long, and not more than eight (8) nor less than four (4) inches wide, square edged and evenly sanded; such decking shall evenly and closely fitted together, and well nailed to the stringers with twelve (12) penny nails. The incline <sup>to</sup> of the sidewalk shall not be more than two (2) inches to each six feet

existing measures. Such sidewalks shall be constructed in a substantial and workman like manner.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances relating to the construction of sidewalks, in conflict herewith, in so far only, as they relate to the construction of sidewalks upon the streets described and mentioned in this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
