Ordinance No- 273.

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An Ordinance to amend Section one of Ordinance No- 189, Entitled, "An Ordinance to regulate, and fix the compensation of the Marshal," Approved by the Mayor September 20th, 1899.

The People of the City of Albany do - Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That section one of Ordinance number 189, Entitled, "An Ordinance to regulate, and fix the compensation of the Marshal," Approved by the Mayor, September 20th, 1899, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1: The Marshal of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall receive in full compensation for his services a salary of \$400 - dollars per year, which shall be paid monthly out of the treasury the same as other claims against the city are audited, and paid

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after the first Monday in January, 1900.
