An Ordinance to License, Tax, and regulate  
Vehicles, in the City of Albany, Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do  
Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That, the owner of any Hack, Cab, Hackney, Coach,  
Carriage, Wagon, Cart, or other vehicle, used for the  
transportation of passengers, or any article of trade,  
mail, ballast, building material, or other substance  
within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon  
(except persons carrying, or delivering their own  
personal property), with, or without compensation, or hire,  
either directly, or indirectly, shall pay a license in the  
amount prescribed, and required by section 121, of  
Ordinance No. 181: Provided that nothing contained in  
this Ordinance shall be construed so as to require  
persons drawing dirt, gravel, or lumber for the  
improvement of the public alleys, bridges, crossings,  
streets, or highways of the city, or drawing wood, gravel,  
or other commodities from outside the city limits, or  
plowing, or scraping the public alleys, streets, railroads,  
or other public improvements, or persons engaged in the  
sale of milk, or dairy products, within the city, or hotel  
keepers for omnibuses run by them for the sole  
purpose of carrying passengers without hire, or charge,  
between their respective hotels, and the depot, or steam boat  
landing, in said city, to procure a license

Section 2: That, all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in  
conflict with this Ordinance be, and the same  
are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in  
full force from, and after its approval by the  
Mayor.
