

Ordinance  
No 315

An Ordinance Authorizing and Empowering the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into, and sign written articles of agreement with the Albany Electric Light, Power, and Telephone Company of Albany, Oregon, their associates, and assigns for furnishing the city of Albany, Oregon, with "Ac" and Incandescent Electric Lights for a term of three years from the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1896.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That, the Mayor and Recorder of the city of Albany, Oregon, be, and are hereby authorized, and directed and empowered to enter into and sign on behalf of the City of Albany, written articles of agreement with the Albany Electric Power, and Telephone Company of Albany, Oregon, their associates, and assigns, for furnishing the City of Albany, for the term of three years from the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1896, with fifteen (15) Electric Arc Street Lights (2000) two thousand candle power, all, and continuous night service, at the price of (\$130.) One Hundred and thirty dollars per month, being at the rate of \$8.66 2/3. per month for each of said 15 lights. The price to be paid for each additional light, which may be ordered by the Common Council of said City, and furnished to the City above the number 15, to be (\$9.00) per month each. Such additional arc lights to be of the same power, and time of service as the original 15 arc light contracted for, and shall be used by the City, and be a part of the contract during the term, and continuance of the contract authorized by this Ordinance.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
