An Ordinance to amend Section 4 of "An Ordinance to provide for licensing, taxing, regulating and restraining the sale or disposal of spirituous liquors, brandy, wine, and all fermented and malt liquors, beer and ale, and prohibiting the sale or disposal of spirituous liquors, brandy, wine and all fermented and malt liquors, beer and ale, without a license" passed by the Council July 12th 1887, and approved by the Mayor July 18th 1887.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:—

Sec. 1:— That Section 4 of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to provide for licensing, taxing, regulating and restraining the sale or disposal of spirituous liquors, brandy, wine and all fermented and malt liquors, beer and ale, and prohibiting the sale or disposal of spirituous liquors, brandy, wine and all fermented and malt liquors, beer and ale, without license," passed by the Council July 12th 1887, and approved by the Mayor July 18th 1887; be amended so as to read as follows:— "Sec. 1:— That every person applying for a license to sell spirituous, malt fermented and wine liquors in quantities less than one quart, shall pay into the treasury of the City of Albany the sum of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) in U. S. gold coin semi-annually, taking therefor the receipt in duplicate of the officer receiving the same, and every person applying for a license to sell ale and beer only, in quantities less than one quart, shall pay into the treasury of the City of Albany, the sum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) in U. S. gold coin, semi-annually, taking therefor the receipt in duplicate of the officer receiving the same.

Sec. 2:— This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
