An ordinance to establish the grade of Geary street between First Street and Salem Road in the City of Albany; and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The established grade of Geary Street between First Street and Salem Road, in the City of Albany, shall be in conformity with the survey and plat thereof made by J. A. Warner, City Engineer and filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 13th day of June, 1905.

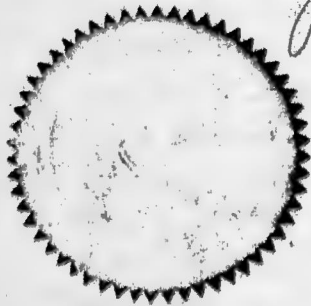
Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
