

## ORDINANCE No. 522

## Declaring surplus paving Ferry Street

An Ordinance declaring a surplus on account of Street paving by the Warren Construction Company, as per Contract, on Ferry Street from the North curb line of Third Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany, to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon said portion of said Ferry Street, heretofore assessed for making such improvement, and entered upon the books of City Liens of said City of Albany, Oregon, their proportional share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of nine and one third per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and the Warren Construction Company, for the improvement of Ferry Street, from the North curb line of Third Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street, and in favor of each of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate, abutting upon said portion of said Ferry Street, heretofore assessed for making such improvement as their several interests may appear.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the books of City Liens, in the surplus column thereof, a credit of nine and one third per cent based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said portion of said Ferry Street, said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners of such various parcels of real estate in the several increments as follows, to wit:
