

ORDINANCE NO. 523

Declaring surplus paving Broadalbin Street

Ord No 523

An Ordinance declaring a surplus on account of street paving by the Warren Construction Company, as per contract, for paving Broadalbin Street, from the North curb line of Third Street to the North curb line of Ninth Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, and directing the Recorder of said City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon said portion of said Broadalbin Street, heretofore assessed for making such improvement, and entered upon the docket of City Liens of said City of Albany, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Secton 1. That a surplus of six and three fourths per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and the Warren Construction Company for the improvement of Broadalbin Street, from the North curb line of Third Street, to the North curb line of Ninth Street, and in favor of each of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon said portion of said Broadalbin Street, heretofore assessed for making such improvement as their several interests may appear.

Secton 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, is hereby directed to enter in the docket of City Liens in the surplus column thereof, a credit of six and three fourths per cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said portion of said Broadalbin Street, said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, Owners of such various parcels of real estate, in the several amounts, as follows, to wit:
