

Ord 512

An ordinance requiring the Northern Pacific Company to place automatic warnings on the wire operated and used for the purpose of crossing the Santiam road and Main street in the City of Astoria, Oregon, and providing a fine to be assessed to any person who fails to comply with this ordinance.

Whereas the Northern Pacific Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Oregon, is the owner and possessor of the wire operated and used for the purpose of crossing the Santiam road and Main street in the City of Astoria, Oregon, and whereas it is the duty of the City of Astoria to protect the public safety and health by requiring the said company to place automatic warnings on the wire operated and used for the purpose of crossing the Santiam road and Main street in the City of Astoria, Oregon, and to provide for the assessment of a fine to any person who fails to comply with this ordinance;

Section 1. The City of Astoria, Oregon, as follows:

Section 1. The Northern Pacific Company is hereby instructed and required to place, install and maintain a practical and working cross within thirty days from the passage and approval of this ordinance, as in and to the crossings at the intersection of the said Santiam road or road with the Northern Pacific Company at Santiam road and at Main Street in the City of Astoria, Oregon.

Section 2. Any person who fails to comply with this ordinance within thirty days from the passage and approval of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof by the District Court shall be fined in a sum not more than \$500 and shall be liable to a fine for each day which said person or persons fail to comply with this ordinance.

Section 3. In case any dispute or controversy arises as to the validity, effect and purpose of this ordinance, or if an emergency exists and an emergency is shown by the facts and the ordinance is necessary for the public safety, health and morals and it is the duty of the City of Astoria to enforce the same and to take any action necessary to enforce the same.
