

Ordinance No. 628

Ord. No. 628

An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 417 entitled "An ordinance to provide for the prevention of fires and the protection of persons and property endangered thereby, and to establish and define the fire limits of the City of Albany, and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith" passed the council of said City on the 22nd day of May, 1906, approved by the Mayor May 24th, 1906.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 417 entitled "An ordinance to provide for the prevention of fires and the protection of persons and property endangered thereby, and to establish and define the fire limits of the City of Albany, and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith" passed by the council of said City on the 22nd day of May, 1906, approved by the Mayor May 24th, 1906, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The fire limits of the City of Albany shall be bounded by a line commencing where the center line of Water Street intersects the center line of Washington Street, and running thence Southerly following the center line of Washington Street to a point equally distant from the center line of Second Street and Third Street, thence Easterly parallel with the center line of Second Street to the center of Ferry Street at a point equally distant from Second Street and Third Street, thence Southerly along the center of Ferry Street to the center line of Third Street, thence Easterly along the center line of Third Street to a point in the center of said Third Street 100 feet westerly from the east line of Lyon Street; thence Southerly parallel with the west line of Lyon Street and 100 feet westerly from said line to a point in the middle of Seventh Street which is 100 feet west from the west line of said Lyon Street; thence Easterly along the center of said Seventh Street to a point in the center of Seventh Street 100 feet easterly from the east line of said Lyon Street; thence Southerly parallel with the East line of Lyon Street and 100 feet therefrom to the center of Second Street, thence Easterly following the center line of Second Street to its intersection with the center line of Baker Street, thence Northerly following the center line of Baker Street to a point equally distant from the center lines of First Street and Water Street, thence Westerly parallel with the center line of First Street to the center line of Lyon Street, thence Northerly following the center line of Lyon Street

to the center line of Water Street, thence Westward following the center line of Water Street to the place of beginning.

Section 2. Whereas this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its approval by the Mayor.
