

Ord No 644

An Ordinance to amend Section 53 of Ordinance No. 633 of the City of Albany, entitled "An ordinance regulating the construction, erection, raising, lowering, alteration, repair and use of buildings and to provide for protection against fire and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance," passed by the council April 28th, 1913, approved by the Mayor April 28th, 1913.

The People of The City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows.

Section 1. That Section 53 of Ordinance No. 633 of the City of Albany, entitled "An Ordinance regulating the construction, erection, raising, lowering, alteration, repair and use of buildings and to provide for protection against fire and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance," passed by the council April 28th, 1913, approved by the Mayor April 28th, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 53. No person shall, within the City of Albany, erect, place or maintain, or cause or suffer to be placed or maintained upon or over any street or sidewalk of said city in front of or adjacent to any building, structure or premises therein, or otherwise, any sign, advertisement, flag, or other contrivance; except on election day and days of public parade; provided that electric signs may be hung on sidewalks in front of buildings, as far out as to the curb line in front of such buildings and as farther, and the bottom of said electric signs shall not be less than ten feet above the level of the sidewalk over which they are placed, signs may be hung over sidewalks in front of buildings so as not as three feet from the property line; provided that the height of the bottom of said signs shall not be less than eight feet above the curb of the sidewalk.
