An ordinance requiring the Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway Company to repair certain portions of First Street and Lyon Street occupied by the Railway line of said company.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. The Portland Eugene & Eastern Railway Company is hereby required to repair and put in good condition that portion of the street occupied by it beginning on First Street, a little west of the west line of Lyon Street and running thence Easterly and Southerly along Lyon Street, by replacing all paving bricks not in good condition, the same to be laid in cement with sand cushion and flush with the established grade of the street and by repairing all paving between its tracks in such a manner that said paving shall be flush with the grade of the street and so that the same shall match smoothly crossing as the present condition of First Street between Alloworth and Broadalbin streets.

Section 2. That the said improvement shall be done and completed within 60 days from the passing of this ordinance.
