

Ord No
671

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Fifth Street, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damages to the City of Albany by the persons or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time aforesaid, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice, which for the completion of such improvement, said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North Curb line of Fifth Street shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First. By grading said street to the required subgrade.
Second. By grading said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, to be six feet wide.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Chicago, and the plans and specifications and estimate of the City Engineer, for the improvement of Hill Street, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 20th day of June, 1913, and signed by the City Engineer, plans and specifications for the improvement of Hill Street from the South line of First Street to the North Curb line of Fifth Street and the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereon.

The cost of said improvement of said portion of said Hill Street at the crossings or intersections of Hill Street with other streets shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the Public Fund of said City; the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement of said Hill Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessment heretofore made, retained and declared by Ordinance No. 670 passed by the Council of said City of Albany on the 20th day of August, 1913, and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 26th day of August, 1913, on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of Hill Street to be assessed, provided, and especially and particularly brought thereby, as provided by the Ordinance of said City.

The improvement of said Hill Street shall be completed by the 15th day of October 1913.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with a row and contract may be entered into for the city for the making of said improvement before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing of such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety in the sum of two hundred dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 1. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Hill Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 2. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of Hill Street, by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Hill Street.
