

ORDINANCE NO. 686

Ord 686 An ordinance requiring the Portland, Eugene and Eastern Railway Company to repair and maintain its street railway car in the City of Albany, Oregon, its passenger cars in first class condition or order.

Whereas on the 20th day of May, 1909, the Council of the City of Albany chose to make a by-laws ordinance, to the following effect, that the Portland, Eugene and Eastern Railway Company, to repair and maintain its street railway or passenger cars in first class condition, or order, or so as will make it possible to run efficient service in the supplying of cars for passengers and for the public use at any time during the said term of this ordinance, according to the terms of the law from time to time, Albany shall have the right, after the failure or refusal of the said company, to cause for, and if the said company after due notice in writing to the city of Albany iniquitously to neglect or omit to do any work required to be done, to demand payment of the sum of \$1000, and to sue for the same, and the city council of

said City of Albany may require by resolution, or ordinance already passed, that the said company's street railway and passenger cars be repaired, cleaned and painted, and the same to be put in first class condition for the public use, and the city council,

Whereas, at no time the cars used upon the streetcar tracks in Portland, Eugene and Eastern Railway Company, or in any other place, were, in the opinion of the Mayor, bad, unclean, unhygienic, without air current and a disgrace to the City of Albany and the said Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway Company;

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany do hereby enact

Sect. 1. That the said Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway Company is hereby required within 60 days from the receipt of a certified copy of this ordinance to furnish to the Mayor in his passenger car or cars in first class condition or order, sufficiently equipped and in good

Sect. 2. In case one of the said cars is not to be furnished

be further be it enacted upon, &c. etc., the manner of
said so that, under the name of Railway Company in Albany,
to give, a certified copy of this ordinance.
