Ord No 719.

An ordinance to Amend Sections 4 and 16 of Ordinance No 570 entitled An ordinance regulating the plumbing, ventilation and drainage of buildings in the City of Urbana, Illinois, providing for the appointment of an inspector of plumbing, prescribing his qualifications, powers, duties and compensation and providing a penalty for violation thereof. Passed the council June 12, 1912, and approved June 12, 1912.

The Provisions of the Ordinance Amendatory Follows

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No 570 entitled "An ordinance regulating the plumbing, ventilation and drainage of buildings in the City of Urbana, Illinois, providing for the appointment of an inspector of plumbing, prescribing his qualifications, powers, duties and compensation and providing a penalty for violation thereof" as amended by an ordinance passed June 12, 1912, and approved June 12, 1912 and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 4. There is hereby added to the duties of the building inspector, the powers and duties of the inspector of plumbing.

Section 2. That Section 16 of Ordinance No 570 entitled "An ordinance regulating the plumbing, ventilation and drainage of buildings in the City of Urbana, Illinois, providing for the appointment of an inspector of plumbing, prescribing his qualifications, powers, duties and compensation and providing a penalty for violation thereof" as amended by an ordinance passed June 12, 1912, and approved June 12, 1912 and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 16. The inspector of plumbing shall issue a permit to any one who is installing plumbing in any building in the City of Urbana, and if any person shall violate the provisions of any ordinance or law of the City of Urbana, relating to plumbing, or any other ordinance or law of the City of Urbana, relating to plumbing, he shall be liable for a fine of five dollars for each violation.
