

Sawling: Albany, Oregon

An ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in Oak Street trunk sewer, which is about midway between Santiam Road and Salem Road in the City of Albany, Oregon and running thence westerly 350 feet, in the City of Albany, Oregon and to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable costs of such improvement that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement, to direct the Recorder of the City of Albany to set a statement of such assessment in the record of City views as provided in the charter of said city.

Whereas the city engineer in pursuance of the directions of the council of the City of Albany made plans, specifications and estimates for the construction of a sewer beginning at the manhole in Oak Street trunk sewer, which is about midway between Santiam Road and Salem Road in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly 350 feet, in the City of Albany, Oregon, and filed such plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 8th day of April, 1914, and

Whereas the council on the 11th day of November, 1914, by Resolution No. 30 duly adopted by said council determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proper to construct said lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in Oak Street trunk sewer, which is about midway between Santiam Road and Salem Road in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly 350 feet, in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 30, and

Whereas in and by said Resolution No. 30, adopted as aforesaid by the council, the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed sewer improvement as provided by the charter of the City of Albany; and

Whereas the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and

Whereas the said council in and by said Resolution No. 30 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement to be paid with the owner of the real property adjacent to said improvement as indicated in said Resolution No. 30 to be the sum of \$273.43

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That an eight inch vitrified terra cotta lateral sewer shall be laid beginning at the manhole in Oak Street trunk sewer, which is a point midway between Santiane Road and Talene Road in the City of Albany, Oregon and running thence westerly 250 feet, in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Let it be in accordance with said plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the city engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 8th day of April, 1914.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner heretofore determined in the Council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 39 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$273.43 and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the parties to adjacent and especially and particularly benefited thereby is the sum of \$273.43.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement as assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 39 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof, as follows:

Beginning at a point which is South 90° East 4.42 chains distant from the N.W. corner of Block No. 17 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, running thence South 90° East 4.25 chains, thence North 80° 15' West 2.27 chains, thence South 90° West 2.98 chains, thence North 81° East 2.68 chains to the place of beginning, also, Beginning at a point which is South 90° East 60 feet distant from the N.W. corner of Block No. 17 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence South 90° East 2.01 chains, thence North 81° West 2.68 chains, thence North 80° West 3.71 chains, thence North 80° East 2.69 chains to beginning, except that portion thereof occupied by the Cable & Electric Railway Company and also except the following: Beginning at a point which is South 90° East 100 feet distant from the N.W. corner of Block No. 17 in Hackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence North 7° West 89 feet, thence North 81° West 88 feet, thence South 7° East 89 feet, thence South 81° West 88 feet to beginning.
