

Lawing, Albany, Oregon

An Ordinance declaring a surplus on accounts of the improvement by Asphalt Machinery Company of Second Street from the east line of Lyon Street to the west curb line of Main Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners, or various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement, heretofore assessed and entered of record in the Booklet of City Sums in the City of Albany, Oregon, for making over and amount to their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of 10.69 per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and Asphalt Machinery Company for the improvement of Second Street from the east line of Lyon Street to the west curb line of Main Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement heretofore assessed for making such improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Booklet of City Sums in the surplus column thereof a credit of 10.69 per cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of improving said street, said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such parcels of real estate and in the sums as follows, to-wit:
