

And Ordinance to provide for open air weekly band concerts during the months of June, July and August, 1916, to provide for warrants to be drawn by the Recorder upon order of the Council for payment for such band concerts, and appropriating the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Dollars for the maintenance of a City Band.

Whereas, at the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Albany, held November 9, 1915, there was presented to said Council a petition signed by a large number of the representative tax payers of the City of Albany requesting the Council to make an appropriation of \$360.00 for the maintenance of a city band to provide weekly open air band concerts during the months of June, July and August, 1916, and

Whereas, the Council of said City of Albany, after considering said petition, believes that it would be beneficial to said city to provide for said concerts, and has voted to appropriate the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Dollars to accomplish said purpose,

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany shall provide for weekly open air band concerts during the months of June, July and August, 1916, and the Recorder of said City is authorized and directed to issue warrants monthly in payment for said concerts upon bills regularly audited and allowed by the Council.

Section 2. That there be and there is hereby appropriated the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Dollars for the maintenance of a city band to provide the weekly open air concerts, provided in Section 1 of this ordinance.
