

ORDINANCE NO. 548.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE ENGINE FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND TO APPROPRIATE MONEY THEREFOR.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund of the City treasury of the City of Albany, Oregon, not otherwise appropriated, for the purchase from A.G.Long, of One "Metropolitan" Steam Fire Engine, 2nd size, registered number 3178, second hand, for the City of Albany, Oregon..

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the City Treasurer payable to the said A.G.Long, for the amount hereby appropriated.
