ORDINANCE NO. 896

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING WIR THE TIME AND PARTIER OF IN-PROVING THE ATTEN IN BEFOR HO. 3 OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORE-CON PRODUCTHE WEST LINE OF FERRY STREET TO THE EAST LIVE OF WARHTHOTON STREET, PROVIDING HOW THE COST OF SAID IMPROVE-MENT SHALL BE PAID, THE PERALTY OR DAMAS TO THE CITY OF ANDAMY BY THE PERSON OF PERSONS TAKING SUCH INTROVIDENT IF THE BAME SHALL NOT BE COMPLETED WITHIN THE TIME AGREED UPOH, AND THE CIVING OF A GOOD AND SUPPLIEST BOND FOR THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF THE WORK OF SHOR IMPROVEDING DE SAID FORTION OF PATE AT LET AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING TY THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY OF PROPER TOTICE FOR BIDS FOR THE COMPLETION OF CUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID TORTION OF SAID ALLLY.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ATTACK TO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "hat the alley in Block No. 3 of the City of Albany, Oregon, from the West line of Ferry Streat to the East line of Washington Street shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First

: By grading said allow to the proper subgrade.
: By paving the rondway of said alloy full width with asphaltic concrete pavenent on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
: By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete and wood headers. Second : By paving

Third

Fourth: By constructing inlets.
Fifth: By laying witrified sower pipe.

Baid improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of said alley, filed in the office of the Recorder of said fity of Albany, Oregon, on the 9th day of May, 1917, and indorsed, "kingineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of the alley in Block No. 3 in the City of Albany, Gregon, and the optimate of the work to be done on said alloy and the probable cost there-00.9

The cost of said improvement of said parties of said alley in Block No.3 shall be maid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereinafter to be made, ascortained and declared by the "ouncil of the City of Albany, on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of anid alley so to be improved, and aspecially and particularly benefitted thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City.

The said improvement of said portion of said alley thall be completed by the 15th day of August, 1917.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said siley deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any person, firm or cornoration with whom any contract may be entered into by the fity of Albay for the making of said improvement shall, before commonsing eatd improvement and at the time of signing such contrast, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with mod and sufficient surety

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thereon, to be approved by the Payor of the City of Albeny in a sum equal to 50 of the total amount to be paid under such contract, for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2% If any person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the C'ty of Albany to make said improvement of said alley shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$10,00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unlers the time for the completion of said improvement is extended by the founcil.

Section 3. The Recorder of unid City is heappy ordered and directed to immedintely give proper notice for hide for the making of said improvement of said portion of eaid alloy by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the timened man for of doingthe work of said improvement of said alley.
