

ORDINANCE NO. 987.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GEORGE H. BOOM AND C.E. DAVIS, CO-PARTNERS OPERATING AND DOING BUSINESS UNDER THE FIRM NAME OF BOOM & DAVIS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF PINE STREET FROM THE NORTH LINE OF SALEM ROAD NORTH TO THE WILLAMETTE RIVER.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 978 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Pine Street from the North line of Salem Road north to the Willamette River be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First :By grading said street to the proper grade.

Second :By graveling said street.

Third :By constructing inlets.

Fourth:By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Fifth:By grubbing and clearing.

Sixth:By tapping sewer.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit; on the 7th day of April 1921, Geo H. Boom and C.E. Davis, co-partners presented to the Council of the City of Albany, its bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by the law and the Council, by which said bid George H. Boom and C.E. Davis co-partners, proposed to furnish all materials and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices, to-wit:

Excavation, per cubic yard	\$ 0.80
Fill, per cubic yard, excess,	0.80
Crushed gravel, per yard,	2.50
One tapping sewer Two inlets, style "A", each, 66 ft. 6 inch vitrified sewer pipe)	125.00
Grubbing	150.00
Estimated total	1390.00

AND WHEREAS, the said George H. Boom and C.E. Davis, co-partners was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

ORDINANCE NO. 387.

Section 1. That the bid of George H. Boom and C.E. Davis, co-partners for said improvement of said described portion of Pine Street be and the same is hereby accepted and the mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said George H. Boom and C.E. Davis co-partners, for the making of said improvement on behalf of the City of Albany Oregon, upon the terms in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of August, 1921, and the city of Albany, Oregon shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$ 10.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said George H. Boom and C.E. Davis, co-partners, furnish a bond in the sum of One Thousand Dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having a surety some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of George H. Boom and C.E. Davis, co-partners and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.


