

ORDINANCE NO. 1014.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING, DETERMINING, DECLARING AND LEVYING A TAX FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UPON THE ASSESSMENT MADE IN THE YEAR 1921, SAID TAX TO BE COLLECTED IN THE YEAR 1922; ALSO, MAKING, DETERMINING, DECLARING AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT FOR EACH OFFICE OR OFFICER, DEPARTMENT, BUILDING, STRUCTURE, INSTITUTION, BRIDGE, ROAD, HIGHWAY AND STREET:

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, in pursuance of Chapter 113 of the General Laws of the State of Oregon, of the year 1921, duly appointed a number of qualified electors and freeholders of the said City of Albany, equal to the numbers of members of the Council of said City of Albany and to constitute a Budget Committee.

WHEREAS, Thereafter the said Budget Committee of the said City of Albany, Oregon, duly and regularly met in session for the purpose of preparing estimates of the proposed expenditures for the year 1922 for the City of Albany, Oregon, and the said Budget Committee duly and regularly organized, as by law required, by electing a chairman and secretary and proceeded with the preparation of the proposed budget for the year 1922.

WHEREAS, The said Budget Committee as required by law, did duly prepare and file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, estimates of the proposed expenditures of the said City of Albany, Oregon, caused notice to be given to the tax payers of the said City of Albany, of said proposed expenditures by publication in the Albany Evening Herald, a newspaper published in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and of general circulation; said notice being published as required by Chapter 113 of the General Laws of the State of Oregon for the year 1921, said notice further providing that an opportunity be given the tax payers of said City to appear before the said Council of said City of Albany, on the 30th day of November, 1921, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of considering and permitting the said tax payers to discuss the said proposed budget and make objections thereto.

WHEREAS; the said Council of the said City of Albany met in adjourned session on the 30th day of November, 1921 at the time provided in said notice as hereinabove stated and that at said time, nor any time prior thereto, were there any objections made or filed concerned or against said proposed expenditures or to any part thereof.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, does hereby make, ascertain, determine and declare the amount of taxes to be levied upon the assessment for the year 1921, and the taxes to be collected in the year 1922, be and the same is hereby made as follows:

said tax levy shall be levied upon the assessed valuation of all assessable property, both real and personal, in the said City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon as shown upon the assessment roll of Linn County, Oregon, which said assessment was made in the year 1921.

Section II The Council of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon does hereby make, determine, declare and appropriate for each office and officer, department, building, structure, bridge, institution, road, highway and street for the year 1922, the several amounts hereinabove set forth.

SECTION III. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon is hereby ordered and directed to immediately notify the County Clerk and County Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, of this levy as provided by law.

SECTION IV. Whereas, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany, that this Ordinance shall become immediately effective, an emergency is here by declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
