

ORDINANCE No. 1107

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE Making, determining, declaring and levying a tax for the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, a municipal corporation, upon the assessment made upon real and personal property for the year 1923, said tax to be collected in the year 1924; also making, determining, declaring and appropriating the amount for each office or officer, department, building, structure, institution, bridge, road, highway and street.

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, in pursuance of Chapter 116 of the General Laws of the State of Oregon, for the year 1921, as amended, duly appointed a number of qualified electors and freeholders of the City of Albany, equal to the number of members of the Council of said City of Albany, and to constitute a Budget Committee, which said appointment was made by resolution of said Council No. 28, passed on the 25th. day of July, 1923, by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, and filed on the 26th. day of July, 1923, in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, Thereafter said Budget Committee of said City of Albany, Oregon, duly and regularly met in session for the purpose of preparing estimates of the proposed expenditures for the year 1924 for the City of Albany, Oregon, and the said Budget Committee duly and regularly organized as by law required by electing chairman and secretary and proceeded with the preparation of the proposed budget for the year 1924, and

WHEREAS, Said Budget Committee as required by law did duly prepare and file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, estimates of the proposed expenditures of said City of Albany, Oregon, for the year 1924, which said proposed budget was so filed prior to the 1st. day of October, 1923, in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did on the 29th. day of September, 1923, duly pass a resolution wherein and whereby said budget so prepared and filed in the office of the Recorder of said City was adopted as and for the proposed budget of the City of Albany for the year 1924 and as and for the budget of the Common Council of the City of Albany for said year, and

WHEREAS, The Recorder of said City of Albany was, in and by said resolution last above named, duly authorized and directed to submit said detailed estimates of the annual budget of the City of Albany to the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission of Linn County, Oregon, and file the same in the Office of said Commission on or before the 1st. day of October, 1923, together with the original estimate sheets of each officer and department of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, which said budget estimates and the original estimates sheet were prepared and in full compliance with Chapter 208 of the General Laws of the state of Oregon for the year 1921 as amended by

Chapter 142 of the General Laws of the State of Oregon for the year 1923, and

WHEREAS, The Tax supervising and conversation Commission of Linn County, Oregon, has duly considered said budget and fully examined the detailed estimates of proposed expenditures, and further has had a public hearing upon the same, and

WHEREAS, The Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission of Linn County, Oregon, did by an order of said Commission dated the 4th. day of December, 1923, find, declare and direct that the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to direct and levy a tax in the sum of \$57,648.90, and

WHEREAS, The Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission of Linn County, Oregon, has duly notified the city of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, of said order and further ordered and directed the Common Council of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, to make such levy in compliance with the order of said commission.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon does hereby made, ascertain determine and declare the amount of taxes to be levied upon the assessment of real and personal property for the year 1923, and said tax to be collected in the year 1924, be and the same is hereby made as follows:
