

ORDINANCE NO. 1150

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To amend Ordinance No. 136 entitled "An Ordinance Relating to City Elections and the City Organization and Manner of Conducting Elections" passed by the Council on May the 12th. 1885, and approved by the Mayor, May the 13th. 1885, as amended by Ordinance No. 743 passed by the Council on the 26th. day of August, 1914, and approved by the Mayor the 27th. day of August, 1914, to read as follows:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 136 entitled "An Ordinance Relating to City Elections and the City Organization and Manner of Conducting Elections" passed by the Council May the 12th. 1885 and approved by the Mayor May the 13th. 1885, as amended by Ordinance No. 743 passed by the Council on the 26th. day of August, 1914, and approved by the Mayor the 27th. day of August, 1914, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That for the purposes of municipal representation, the City of Albany be and is hereby divided into three Wards designated and bounded as follows: Ward No. One (1) is hereby declared to include all that part of said City being West of the middle of Broadalbin Street to Fourth Street, thence along the center of Fourth Street to a point opposite the center of the Court House, thence South to the center of Fifth Street, thence East to the center of Broadalbin Street, thence South along the center of Broadalbin Street to the Southern boundary of the City. Ward No. Two (2) is hereby declared to include all that part of said City lying East of the Eastern boundary of Ward No. One (1) to the center of Railroad Street. Ward No. Three (3) is hereby declared to include all that portion of the City lying East of Ward No. Two (2)
