

ORDINANCE No. 1186

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon to enter into a contract with Guy F. Pyle for the improvement of Calapooia Street from the south line of Ninth Street to the North curb line of Thirteenth Street in said City.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1180 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following Street in said City be improved, to-wit: Calapooia Street from the south line of Ninth Street to the North curb line of Thirteenth Street, in the following manner:

- 1st: By grading said Street to the proper sub-grade.
- 2nd: By paving the roadway of said Street, full width, with full intersections (except as noted in the plans and specifications) with Warrenite Bitulithic pavement, or with Portland Cement Concrete pavement, or with Bituminous Concrete pavement;
- 3rd: By laying and constructing pavement headers;
- 4th: By constructing concrete curbs wherever necessary;
- 5th: By constructing catch basins and inlets;
- 6th: By laying vitrified sewer pipes;
- 7th: By tapping the main sewer.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany, and;

WHEREAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinances aforesaid, to-wit: on the 27th day of May, 1925, Guy F. Pyle presented to the Council of the City of Albany, his bid for making said improvement, with Warrenite bitulithic pavement, which said bid was and is in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid said Guy F. Pyle proposed to furnish all material and implements and to perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with Warrenite Bitulithic pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

Excavations for 287 cubic yards for Warrenite Bitulithic pavement, @ 90c per cubic yard	\$258.30
6680.5 sq. yds. of Warrenite Bitulithic pavement on a 3" black base, 2" Bitulithic top, after compression, @ \$2.15 per sq. yd.	14463.07
223 sq. yds. of fill or embankment, @ 90c per sq. yd.	200.07
288 lin. feet paving headers, @ 50c. per lin. feet	129.00
8 catch basins, @ \$30.00 each,	240.00
460 feet vitrified sewer pipes @ 80c per foot, lin.	368.00
Tapping main sewer, 2 complete taps, @ \$10.00 each	20.00
1140 lineal feet of curb, @ 50c. per lin. foot	570.00
Total	\$ 16249.07

AND, WHEREAS, said Guy F. Pyle was the lowest and best bidder for said proposed work, and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor,

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of Guy F. Pyle for said improvement of said described portion of Calapooia Street be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Guy F. Pyle for the making of said improvement with Warrenite Bitulithic pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in the said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all of the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or about the 1st day of September, 1925, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$50.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said Guy F. Pyle shall furnish a bond in the sum of Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$8,500.00) to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of said Guy F. Pyle, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim of lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation arising out of said contract.
