AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined to make in Resolution No. 13, adopted by said Council on the 28th day of September, 1927, on Second Street, from the east line of Sherman Street to the west line of Oak Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said portion of said Street that is assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street to be so improved; to authorize and direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City, and declaring an emergency:

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of September, 1927 the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring Charles H. Leonard, engineer, to compile and file in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 28th day of Sep-

pile and file in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 28th day of September, 1927, plans, estimates and specifications of the probable cost of making the improvement of Second Street, in said City, from the east line of Sherman Street to the west line of Oak Street, by grading and gravelling the same; and WHENEAS, the Council of said City on the 28th day of September, 1927, by Resolution No. 18, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that the Council proposed to improve Second Street from the east line of Sherman Street to the west line of Oak Street, in said City of Albany, Orgon, in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 18, and said WHENEAS, and by said Resolution No. 18 the recorder of the City of Albany was duly ordered and directed to give notice of said proposed improved and Street, as provided by the charter and ordinances of said City, and

WHENEAS, the recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Second Street in the manner provided by said resolution, and the charter and ordinances of said City, and

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said resolution No. 18 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street, to be paid by the owners of real property adjacent to said portion of said Street to be improved, as specified in said Resolution No. 18, to be the sum of \$282.12.

And, WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1263, after due notice of the time and in the manner provided by law, the bid of C.E.Davis for the making of said improvement of said portion of said Second Street was accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany were thereby authorized to enter into a contract with C.E.Davis for the making of said improvement in accordance with said bid, by grading and graveling said portion of said Street, and in other respects in accordance with said Resolution No. 18. Resolution No. 18.

THERFORE, THE PROPLE OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Second Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the east line of Sherman Street to the west line of Oak Street, shall be improved as follows:

lst: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade; 2nd: By surfacing the roadway of said Street 16 feet in width with gravel; All in accordance with said Resolution No. 13, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard, City Engineer, with the Recor of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 28th day of September, 1927. with the Recorder

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street from the east line of Sherman Street to the west line of Oak Street, in said City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council, and in and by Resolution No. 18, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Second Street, is hereby declared to be the sum of 2282.12.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Second Street assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street, to be improved as aforesaid, and as determined by said Council in and by said desolution No. 18, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of

such lots, or partsthereof, as follows:
