

ORDINANCE NO. 1306

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer, beginning on the Cottage Street Trunk Sewer on Albany-Corvallis Road in the City of Albany, Oregon, 16 feet southerly from the south-east corner of lot 1 in block 3 in Albany Heights Addition to Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly 334 feet through the center of blocks 3 and 4 of said Albany Heights Addition to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 4 in said Addition; providing how the cost of said improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same be not completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of making such improvement; and providing for the giving of notice for bids for making such improvement by the Recorder of said City.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an 8 inch vitrified terra cotta sewer, beginning on the Cottage Street trunk sewer on Albany-Corvallis Road in the City of Albany, Oregon, 16 feet southerly from the southeast corner of lot 1 in block 3 in Albany Heights Addition to Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly 334 feet through the center of blocks 3 and 4 of said Albany-Heights Addition to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 4 in said Addition, in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications of Charles H. Leonard, engineer, for the making of such improvement, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 23rd day of January, 1929.

The cost of said sewer shall be paid out of funds to be collected and arising out of the assessments to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of said City on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said improvement so to be made, and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the charter of said City.

Said improvement shall be completed on or before the 1st day of May, 1929.

All bids submitted for the making of such improvement deemed by the Council to be unreasonable may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing the same, and at the time of signing such contract, furnish said city with a good and sufficient bond; with good and sufficient surety thereon, to be approved by the Mayor of said City, in a sum equal to at least fifty per cent (50%) of the amount to be paid on such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into such contract with the City of Albany for the making of said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, said City shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00) per day for each and every day the completion of such work is delayed beyond the time so stated in said contract, which amount shall be paid by the contractor doing the work at the time of completion thereof, provided the Council may extend the time for the completion of said sewer should circumstances warrant.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to immediately give proper notice of the time and place for receiving bids for said improvement by publication thereof for ten(10) days in the Albany-Democrat-Herald, a daily newspaper published in the City of Albany, Oregon, describing in such notice the time and manner of making such improvement.
