GRDINANCE NO 1307

AN OrDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with Fred H. Slate for the construction of a lateral/ sewer, beginning on the Cottage Street Trunk Saver on Albany-Corvallis Road, in the City of Albany, Oregon, 16 feet southerly from the south-east corner of lot 1 in block 3 in Albany Heights Addition to Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly 334 feet through the center of blocks 3 and 4 of said Albany Heights Addition to the north-east corner of lot 7 in block 4 in said Addition, by laying an 8" sewer pipe in accordance with the plane and specifications of Charles H. Leonard, engineer, for said lateral sever, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 23rd day of January, 1929.

WHNREAS, by resolution No. 6, adopted by the Council Fabruary 13th, 1929, it was ordered that a lateral sever os constructed deginning on the Cottage Street trunk sewer on Alosny-Corvallie Road, in the City of Alosny, Oregon, 16 feet southerly from the south-east corner of lot 1 in block 3 in Albany Heights Addition to Alesay, Oregon, and running themoe northerly 834 feet through the center of blocke 3 and 4 of said Albany Heights Addition to the north-east corner of lot 7 in block 4 in said Addition, by laying an eight inch sever pipe in accordance with the plans and specifications of Charles H. Leohard, Engineer, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 23rd day of January, 1920, and WHRHMAS, it was provided by ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of such improvement in the manner provided by

law, and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for olds hade and given by the Recorder of the City of Albeny, Olegon, according to said ordinance, Fred H. Slate on the 27th day of Tarch, 1929, presented his bid to the Council of said City for on the 27th day of said improvement, which said oid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and of said ordinance, by which said oid the said Fred H. Slate proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform all the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the sun offil104.40, and
WHEREAS, Fred H. Slate was the lowest bidder for said proposed work, and said
bid was the lowest and pest bid submitted therefor,

THEMSFORE, THE PROPIE OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAL! AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of said Fred H. Slate for said improvement be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and necesser of the City of Albany are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in writing with the said Fred H. Slate for the taking of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Alosay, Oregon, and upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of such contract, and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work emoraced in said contract shall be arrivally associated to the contract. in said contract chall be entirely completed on or before May 1st, 1929, and the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of 25.00 per day each and every day the work is delayed beyond said time.
Said contract chall further provide that said Fred H. Slate shall promptly

as due make payment to all persons supplying to him labor and material for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work, and that he shall not permit any lien or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the City of Albany for or on account of any later or material furnished on account of said work.

Said Fred H. Slate shall furnish a bond in a sum squal to fifty per cent of

the ophtract price, with good and sufficient sureties thereon, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of such contract on the part of said Fred H. Slate, and particularly on account of any lien or claim for labor or material furnished on the part of any person arising cut of such contract.
