

ORDINANCE NO. 1409

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Council of the City of Albany to purchase from The B.F. Goodrich Company 400 feet of two and one-half inch hose and 300 feet of one and one-half inch hose for the Fire Department of said City and appropriating the sum of \$676.20 of the General Funds for the payment of the same and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and it is hereby authorized and directed to purchase from The B.F. Goodrich Company 400 feet of two and one-half inch hose and 300 feet of one and one-half inch hose for the use of the Fire Department of said City at and for the agreed price of \$676.20 net.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated of the General Funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$676.20 in payment of the hose referred to in Section 1 of this Ordinance and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver to The B.F. Goodrich Company the General Fund warrant of said City in the amount and for the purpose hereby appropriated.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in immediate force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
