

ORDINANCE No. 1577

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$618.41 from the General Fund, it being the difference between the trade in value of the City's 1941 Ford Sedan and the purchase price of a new 1942 Oldsmobile Sedan, and authorizing the Recorder to execute and deliver a City warrant to Barnard Motors, Inc., for the amount hereby appropriated.

Whereas, the Council of the City of Albany has agreed with Barnard Motors Inc., to trade in the City's 1941 Ford Sedan for a new 1942 Oldsmobile Sedan and to pay to the said Barnard Motors Inc., the sum of \$618.41 difference.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$618.41, it being the difference between the trade in value of the City's 1941 Sedan and the purchase price of a new 1942 Oldsmobile Sedan and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the general fund warrant of said City in the sum of \$618.41, payable to Barnard Motors Inc., upon the delivery by them and the acceptance by the City of said Oldsmobile Sedan.
