

ORDINANCE NO. 1579

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$474.42 of the general funds of the City of Albany for the purchase of the U.S. Government of a quantity of bed springs, mattresses and bedding for public emergency use, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of \$474.42 of the general funds of the City of Albany for the purchase from the U.S. Government of a quantity of bed springs, mattresses and bedding for public use and relief during emergencies, and the Recorder is hereby directed to execute and deliver to the proper U.S. Government agency the City's warrant in the amount hereby appropriated upon delivery of said property to the City.

Section 2. Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
