

ORDINANCE NO. 1665

A Bill for:

An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,750.00 out of the general funds of the City of Albany to be used in payment of the purchase price of 1000 ft. 3½" Fire hose from the Eureka Fire Hose Company and authorizing payment of the same to be made to the Eureka Fire Hose Company.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, and Charged to the Fire Equipment sinking fund of said funds, the sum of \$1,750.00 it being the price heretofore agreed upon with Eureka Fire Hose Company for 1000 ft. of 3½" fire hose as shown by the invoice therefor now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to Eureka Fire Hose Company the general fund warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set forth. That the amount hereby appropriated shall be charged against the Fire Equipment sinking fund of said City.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involed. Therefore, and emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately affective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
