

ORDINANCE NO. 1711

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE vacating the alley running in a northerly and southerly direction through Block A. in Central Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1656 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor the Mayor on the 10th day of October, 1945 it was provided for the time and manner of vacating the alleys running northerly and southerly through Block A. in Central Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon:

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to said Ordinance, the Recorder gave notice of the vacation of said portion of said alleys for the time and in the manner provided by law and said Ordinance, and in said notice it was provided by law and said Ordinance, and in said notice it was provided that December 12th, 1945, at seven-thirty o'clock P.M. of said day be the time set for the hearing of objections to the vacation of said portion of said alleys and this being the time and date set for said hearing and no objections and remonstrances being made or filed to said vacation or any portion thereof.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the alley running in a northerly and southerly direction through Block A. in Central Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated.
