A BILL FOR:

AN CROPPANCE authorizing the Layor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with Leonard & Slate Oregon Ltd for the construction of lateral sewers as follows:

Lateral 1. Beginning at the manhole at the south end of the lateral sewer now in place on the south side of 15th street between Vine and Maple Sts.; and running thence southerly on the East line of Lot 3 in Bl. 1, in Pipe's South albuny add, to the City of Albany, Linn County Oregon to the southeast corner of said lot; running thence Tasterly 90 ft., and westerly slong the center line of Plooks 1 and 2 in said add, and along the center line of Dlock 1 in Schultz Front Add. to said City to the West line of Elr. St. a total distance of 1000. ft.

Lateral 2. Beginning at a point in B. Street near the Southeast corner of Lot 1 in Block 2 in Pire's South Albany Aid. to the City of Albany, Orecon, and running thence southerly in said street a distance of 365 ft. to the northeast corner of Block 5 in said Add.

Lateral 3. Beginning at a point in B. Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oragon at a point 1 ft. easterly from the southeast corner of Let 1 in Block 3 in hi e's Bouth albany addition to said City and running thence Easterly I to Lock 4 in said Addition a distance of 200 ft. and westerly through the center of Block 3 and into Block 2 of Schultz Front Addition and distance of 650 ft. into Block 2 of Schultz Front Addition, a distance of 650 ft.

Lateral 2. Biginnin at a point in 2. Street near the Southeast corner of Lot 1 in Block 2 in Pire's South along add. to the City of Albany, troon, and running thence southerly in said street a dist noe of 365 ft. to ... northeast corner of Block 5 in said Addition.

Threat in the City of Albany, Linn County Teron at a point 1. ft. casterly from the Southeast corner of Lot 1 in lock 3 in first a outh libeny in to said City and running thence test rly into Plock 4 in said A dition a distance of 200 ft. and westerly hround a centur of Block 3 and into distance of 200 ft. and westerly through the center of Block 2 of Schultz Front Addition a distance of 650 ft.

said lateral sewers to be constructed of eight inch with fied torre cotts saver pire in accordance with the plans and specifications of Walter W. Lorsen, Engineer of said City, filed in the office of the Recorder of maid City on the 11th May of September, 1946.

Thereas, it was provide in and by (minance is. 1738) passed by the Council on the 24th day of September, 1946, and at roved by the Layor on the same dat, that the Recorder ive notice for bids for the making of such improvement in the recorder ive notice for bids

for the making of such improvement in the nanner provided by law; and

Thereas, due notice and advertisement for said bids have been made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany in accordance with the provisions of said Ordinance and in the manner provided by law; and

Thereas, Laonard & Slate Ore on Ltd., on the 25th day of Sept., 1946, presented their bid to the Council of said City for the making of said improvement which said bid was rade in due form and in conformity with all the conditions im osed by law and by said ordinance, by which bid the said Leonard & Slate Croson Ltd. proposed to furnish all material, and implements and to perform all the labor

necessary to make the above described improvement for the sum of \$4357.40; and

Whereas, Leonard & Slate Orecon Ltd., was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid submitted therefore.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLIOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of the said Leom rd & Slate Oregon Ltd for said improvement be am the same is hereby accepted am the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement in writing with the said Leonard & Slate Oregon Ltd for the making of said improvement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, wherein, and upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer construction shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced therein shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of November 1946, and the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of 25.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond such time.

Said contract shall further provide that the said Leonard & Slate Oregon Ltd shall, promptly as due, make revment to all parties supplying to him labor and material for the presention of the hereinabove described work and that he will not parmit any lian or claim to be prosecuted against the City of Albany for or on account of any labor or material furnished on said work and shall also pay all contributions or amounts due the State Industrial Accident Fund incurred in the performance of said contract.

Section 2. The said Leonard & Blate Oregon Ltd shall furnish a bond in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the contract price wit; good and sufficient surety thereon to be an roved by the Tayor of the City of Albany, to secure the filthful parfor ance of all the obligations of said contract on the part of the said bidder and articularly on account of any lion or clair for labor or material furnished on the part of any person or present arising out of such contract.

Said contract shall further provide that should the said contractor fail, neglect or refuse to take prospt payment of any claim for labor, wages or materials furnished by any person in connection with said contract as said claim becomes due, whether said labor, wages or materials be furnished for sail contractor or any sub-contractor, then and in such event the Council of the City of Albany may pay such claims to the proper claimants and charge the are against funds due or to become due said contractor by reason of said contract.
