

ORDINANCE NO. 1778

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1681 ✓
 entitled "An Ordinance relating to Traffic and regulating use of
 public streets in the City of Albany, Oregon; Defining and Establish-
 ing Parking Meter Zones and Regulating and Controlling and Providing
 for Inspection of the TIME PARKING of Vehicles therein by the use of
 PARKING METERS; PRESCRIBING limitations of time for parking in
 PARKING METER ZONES; And Providing for Enforcement of this Ordinance
 and Punishment for its Violation", and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be added to Section 2 of
 said Ordinance in which the following portions of streets are hereby
 established as PARKING METER ZONES; by adding to the list of streets
 THIRD STREET from FERRY EAST to BROADALEIN STREET.

Section 2. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of
 the people of the City of Albany are involved. Therefore, an
 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become
 immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and ap-
 proval by the Mayor.
