

## ORDINANCE NO. 1820

## A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$2500.00 out of the General Fund of the City of Albany to be used in payment for plans and specifications for the construction of a new Fire Hall Building, and authorizing payment of the same to Cleo H. Jenkins.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Albany and charged to the Fire Hall Sinking Fund the sum of \$2500.00, it being the price heretofore agreed upon with Cleo H. Jenkins for the said plans and specifications as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to Cleo H. Jenkins the General Fund warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set forth; that the amount hereby appropriated shall be charged against the Fire Hall Sinking Fund of said City.
