

ORDINANCE NO. 1892

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE forbidding the sale and use of firecrackers, fireworks, caps, bombs or detonating materials of any description within the City of Albany, providing a penalty, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to sell, offer for sale, any fireworks, firecrackers, caps, bombs or detonating materials, except ammunition and its components, within the City of Albany.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to fire, discharge, ignite, explode or cause to be fired, ignited, discharged, or exploded any firecracker, fireworks, caps, bombs or detonating materials of any description within the City of Albany and shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the City jail for a period of not less than one nor more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
