

ORDINANCE NO. 1999

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1503 AS AMENDED MAY 10, 1944
BY ORDINANCE NO. 1575

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT CERTAIN CALLINGS, TRADES AND
OCCUPATIONS BE LICENSED, PROVIDING THE MANNER OF ISSUING
LICENSES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

That Section 1 of said ordinance shall read as follows:

Section 1. The businesses, trades and occupations here-
inafter enumerated shall pay the license fee specified in
the following schedule:

Animal Show	\$ 50.00 daily
Bowling alleys, billiard rooms & pool halls per alley or table	5.00 quarterly
Circuses and/or menageries	150.00 daily
Carnivals, exhibitions, shows and entertainments	500.00 weekly 100.00 daily
Fortune Teller	50.00 daily
Juggler	2.50 daily 10.00 weekly
Posting theatrical or other shows	.50 daily 5.00 quarterly
Pawnbroker	50.00 quarterly
Shooting galleries	10.00 weekly 35.00 monthly 100.00 quarterly
Skating rinks Jan. 1st to June 30th	25.00 semi-annually
July 1st to Dec. 31st	25.00 semi-annually
Theatres - 300 seats or under	50.00 annually
301 seats to 500	75.00 annually
501 or over	100.00 annually

Further, that Section 4 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Every person, firm, corporation or association
required by this ordinance to obtain a license to engage in
any trade, business, occupation or profession for which a
license is required shall pay to the City Treasurer the sum
of money required by ordinance in payment thereof; thereupon,
with the receipt of the City Treasurer setting forth the kind
of business, trade, occupation or profession for which said
license is desired, they shall apply to the City Recorder who
shall issue such license in accordance with the receipt from
the City Treasurer upon the compliance of the applicant with
the provisions of all ordinances relating to obtaining licenses
for the business, trade, occupation or profession for which
said license is desired.
