

ORDINANCE NO. 216

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 1664 which is

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF BICYCLES
WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

That Section 2 of said ordinance shall be amended so as to
read as follows:

Section 2. That all owners and operators of bicycles
within the city of Albany, Oregon shall make application and
register such bicycle as provided in Section 1, on and before
January 31, 1950. Such registrant as might have previously
registered his bicycle and has retained the numbered license
tag shall retain said number and the re-registration be noted
in the Police Department of the City of Albany. That a further
registration shall be required on or before January 31, 1952
and each bi-annual period thereafter. When a registrant
has sold or disposed of his bicycle, the registration shall
be cancelled and the new owner shall obtain registration in
his own name. All applications shall be accompanied by a
fee of \$ 0 .25 to cover the cost of registration and tags.
