

ORDINANCE NO. 2369

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A CERTAIN 600 GALLON ASPHALT SPRAY TANK FOR TRUCK MOUNTING FROM FEENAUGHTY MACHINERY COMPANY

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids on a 600 gallon Asphalt Spray Tank for truck mounting, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany at a regular Council meeting on the 14th day of May, 1952, did by motion duly seconded and passed award the Contract for the purchase of the said equipment to Feenaughty Machinery Company.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

That the Mayor and the City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a Contract with Feenaughty Machinery Company for the purchase of 600 gallon Asphalt Spray tank for truck mounting at the bid price of \$2,210.00.

Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
