

ORDINANCE NO. 2455

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH IRWIN HODSON COMPANY IN THE SUM OF \$278.25 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids on the printing of five hundred fifty (550) ONE THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$1,000.00) bonds being Albany Sewer Bonds Series 1952, and

WHEREAS, the said bids were opened at a special council meeting on the 5th day of December, 1952, and

WHEREAS, the Irwin Hodson Company was determined to have entered the best bid.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Irwin Hodson Company for the printing of five hundred fifty (550) ONE THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$1,000.00) City of Albany Sewer Bonds Series 1952 and the necessary attached coupons all in accordance with the notice to receive bids prepared by the City Recorder pertaining thereto in the sum of \$278.25.

Inasmuch as the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary to the health, safety and peace of the citizens of the City of Albany in that it is necessary to have the bids printed at the earliest possible moment to effect delivery thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force immediately upon the passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
