

ORDINANCE NO. 2463

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY'S REGULAR MEETINGS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF ITS RULES FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF ITS MEMBERS AND ITS PROCEEDINGS BY RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Albany, Oregon, do ordain as follows:

Section 1 That the time of the regular meetings of the city council of the City of Albany shall be the second and fourth Wednesday of each and every month; said meetings to be held in the council chambers at the City Hall in the said city, at the hour of 7:15 o'clock p.m. P.S.T.

Section 2 All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby specifically repealed.

Section 3 The council shall, by resolution, adopt such rules for the government of its members and its proceedings that it deems necessary, provided, however, that the rules once adopted shall not be modified or changed without unanimous consent of all members of the council; said amendments or changes to be made of record as amendment to the Rules Resolution.

Section 4 Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary to the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, in that the conduct of the council meetings may be properly governed, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
