

ORDINANCE NO. 2639

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE E-W CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN THE HAZELWOOD DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for construction of sanitary sewers in the Hazelwood District as previously provided by Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein setforth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany:


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the E-W Construction Company for the construction of sanitary sewers in the Hazelwood District as heretofore provided by Ordinance in the total sum of \$52,786.90 according to the bids submitted.


