

ORDINANCE No. 2644

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY FROM WESTERN WAYS, INCORPORATED, OF CORVALLIS, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany do, by the passage of this ordinance deem it impracticable to obtain bids for aerial photography.


Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of aerial photography for the City of Albany with Western Ways, Incorporated, of Corvallis, Oregon.

Section 3: By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.


