

ORDINANCE No. 2647

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STEVENS & THOMPSON, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, FOR THE REDESIGN OF PORTIONS OF THE ALBANY SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT AND INTERCEPTOR SEWER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Stevens & Thompson, Consulting Engineers, of Portland, Oregon, for the purpose of redesigning certain portions of the Albany Sewage Treatment Plant and the interceptor sewer. Said contract to be under such terms as might be mutually satisfactory between the contracting parties and authorize payment of such reasonable fee as agreed upon in the contract.

Section 2: Whereas, the existing conditions are such that the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Albany, Oregon, are involved, therefor an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its final passage and its approval by the Mayor.
