

ORDINANCE NO. 2680

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DATE AND MANNER FOR HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THAT PORTION OF GOLTRA PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY ON THE 16TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1956, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE SAID TERRITORY FOR THEIR ADOPTION OR REJECTION THE PROPOSAL TO ANNEX THE SAID PORTION OF GOLTRA PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: In a manner provided by law and in this ordinance for the purpose set forth herein, a special election will be held in a portion of Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, as below described, on the 16th day of November, 1956, commencing at the hour of 8:00 o'clock a.m. on the said day and continuing until 8:00 o'clock p.m. on the said day.

Section 2: The following is hereby designated as the voting place of the said election, the same being a voting place within the said territory:

The basement of the Charles R. Draper residence,  
630 E. Queen Avenue.

Section 3: The judges and clerks of the said special election shall supervise the election within the below described territory shall be as follows:

Judges:

- 2. Retta Mae Draper

Clerks:

- 1. Alice Hall
- 2. Lucille K. McConnell
- 3. June C. Northey

Section 4: The City Recorder shall cause notice of the said special election to be given by publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation within the city, once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks. The first date of publication to be on the 19th day of October, 1956, and the said notice shall state the time, voting place and description of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Section 5: The City Recorder, in addition to the notices required in Section 4, shall cause to be posted in four (4) conspicuous places within the territory proposed to be annexed on or before the 19th day of October, 1956, notices of special election to be in the following form:

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 16th day of November, 1956, at Charles R. Draper residence, Albany, Oregon, in the Sunrise precinct, in Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany, a special election will be held concerning the proposed annexation of the following described territory to the City of Albany:

- Beginning at the intersecting point of the north line of Queen Avenue and the east line of Marion Street extended;
- thence south to the southwest corner of Block 1, Goltra Park Addition;
- thence east along the south line of Blocks 1 and 2, Goltra Park Addition to the southwest corner of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition;

thence south along the west line of Blocks 6 & 11, Goltra Park Addition to the south line of "D" Street;  
thence west along the south line of "D" Street five feet;  
thence southerly along the east line of Jackson Street (formerly Park Avenue) 683.0 feet;  
thence easterly parallel to the south line of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition 457 feet; more or less to a point on the present city limits of Albany, Linn County, Oregon;  
thence northerly and westerly following the present city limits of Albany, Oregon, to the place of beginning.

Which election will be held at 8:00 o'clock in the morning and will continue until 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon of the said day.

Registered voters of the said territory are invited to go upon the proposed annexation.

Section 6: The said special election and the proposed annexation of the territory described above shall be submitted to the legal voters in the said territory for their adoption or rejection as hereinafter set forth in Section 7.

Section 7: Proposal to annex the said portion of Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon:

"AN ACT to annex the following described territory, (being a portion of Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon) to the City of Albany:

Beginning at the intersecting point of the north line of Queen Avenue and the east line of Marion Street extended;  
thence South to the southwest corner of Block 1, Goltra Park Addition;  
thence east along the south line of Blocks 1 and 2, Goltra Park Addition to the southwest corner of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition;  
thence south along the west line of Blocks 6 & 11 Goltra Park Addition to the south line of "D" Street;  
thence west along the south line of "D" Street five feet;  
thence southerly along the east line of Jackson Street (formerly Park Avenue) 683.0 feet;  
thence easterly parallel to the south line of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition 457 feet; more or less to a point on the present city limits of Albany, Linn County, Oregon;  
thence northerly and westerly following the present city limits of Albany, Oregon, to the place of beginning.
