

ORDINANCE NO. 2781

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 222.120 ORS, REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF A PORTION OF HAWTHORNE PARK ADDITION, CONTIGUOUS WITH THE CITY OF ALBANY, SETTING A TIME OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of May 1958, there was filed with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, a petition and consent by the petitioners, Rodney W. Tripp, Martha G. Tripp, Russell W. Tripp, Barbara A. Tripp, and Merle Cathey, representing to be the owners of the property, contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon, to elect to dispense with an election within the City of Albany concerning the annexation of the said property and setting a date for public hearing of the same.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an election within the City of Albany regarding the annexation of the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the present City Limits of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, which point is S.  $14^{\circ}12'$  E. 135 feet more or less from the SW corner of the intersection of Liberty Street and 27th Avenue extended:

thence S.  $14^{\circ}12'$  E. 310 feet.

thence N.  $75^{\circ}48'$  E. 60 feet to the East bank of a ditch conveyed to the City of Albany by Deed recorded in Volume 159 on page 174, Deed Records, Linn County, Oregon,

thence Northeasterly along the east bank of said ditch to the present City Limits of the City of Albany;

thence Westerly along the present City Limits to the point of beginning.

and shall be and it is hereby dispensed with pursuant to and under the terms of Section 222.120 ORS.

Section 2: That there shall be a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing the property described in Section 1 to the City of Albany, on the 11th day of June, 1958, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the said City once a week for two (2) successive weeks and by posting in four (4) public places, a notice setting forth the time and place of the said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and, should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
