ORDINANCE NO. 2787

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, THE 1958 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AS PUBLISHED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2606, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That the Uniform Building Code, 1958 Edition, prepared and adopted by International Conference of Building Officials, Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference Subsidiary is hereby adopted, accepted and passed as the Building Code in and for the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon as though the same were fully set forth herein and this reference to said Code makes it a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2:

That Ordinance No. 2606 and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3:

Whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany that this Ordinance shall become immediately operative, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
